37.00 chs. Old cor. bears East 3 lks., I destroy it. (\* 1899 survey is a corrective resurvey of Chandler's 1895 survey. The Orig. 1895 survey was not accepted but some corners were accepted on a case by case basis. Per Eugene's & Coos Bay's BLM offices.)

40.00 chs. Set a Fir post, 3 ft. long, 3" sq., 24" in the ground, for 1/4 secs. cor. mkd: 1/4 S9 on W and 10 on E faces; from which

A Fir, 6" dia., bears N.70°E., 10 lks., mkd: 1/4 S BT.

A Fir, 4" dia., bears S.49°W., 15 lks., mkd: 1/4 S BT.

BLM dependent resurvey by Donald R. Beck & Peter A. Peterson, Cadastral Surveyors, under Group #307, surveyed April 1968/Aug. 1976 (DCSO records Vol. 37 Page(s) 15449-50)

Point for 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 9 & 10, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the orig. corner. Set an iron post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 26" in the ground, with brass cap marked:

A Fir, 16" dia., bears S.35°E., 12 lks., mkd: 1/4 S10 BT.

A Fir, 20" dia., bears S.45°W., 38 lks., mkd: 1/4 S9 BT.
