A Fir, 8" dia., bears N.43°E., 25 lks., mkd: T19S R9W S3 BT.  
A Fir, 7" dia., bears S.52°E., 25 lks., mkd: T19S R9W S10 BT.  
A Fir, 6" dia., bears S.55°W., 14 lks., mkd: T19S R9W S9 BT.  
A Fir, 8" dia., bears N.63°W., 8 lks., mkd: T19S R9W S4 BT.

- A Fir, 18" dia., bears N.25°E., 26 lks., blazed & healed. (rec. N.43°E., 25 lks.)
- A Fir, 12" dia., bears S.59½°E., 18 lks., with scribe marks T19S R9W S10 visible on open blaze. (Rec. S.52°E., 25 lks.)
- A Fir, 24" dia., bears N.46¼°W., 15 lks., blazed & healed (Rec. N.63°W., 8 lks.)

At the corner point, in place of Fir snag,  
Set an iron post, 28" long, 2½" dia., 22" in the ground, with brass cap marked:
