A Dogwood, 6" dia., bears N.7°W., 10 lks.
A Hemlock, 12" dia., bears S.35°W., 16 lks.

The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 21 & 28, determined from the one remaining orig. BT:

A Hemlock, 25" dia., bears S.35°W., 16 lks., showing a blaze facing NE, scribed BT under 78 years overgrowth.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1" dia., 30" in the ground, with brass cap marked:

The sec. cor. of secs. 21 & 28, monumented with an iron post, 1" dia., firmly set, projecting 2" above ground with brass cap (properly) mkd.

A decayed hemlock stump, size indeterminate, bears S.35°W., 10.6 ft. with scribe marks BT visible on partially healed blaze.

and the remains of BTs mkd. by Lytle in 1950

A decayed hemlock stump, size indeterminate, bears S.1¾°W., 29.0 ft. with no marks visible.

A decayed hemlock stump, size indeterminate, bears N.30½°W., 19.8 ft. with no marks visible.

and new BTs

A hemlock, 6" dia., bears N.33°E., 7.1 ft., mkd: ¼ S21 BT

A hemlock, 11" dia., bears S.29¾°E., 8.1 ft mkd: ¼ S18 BT

Each new bearing tree has a 2½"x ¼" magnetic nail (Mag Nail) driven at the base right side-center.
