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Set sandstone, 20x16x5" 16" in the ground, for cor. to secs. 7, 8, 17 & 18, marked with 4 notches on S & 5 notches on E edges; from which

- A V. Maple, 4" dia., bears N.14°E., 20 lks., mkd: T20S R7W S8 BT.
- A Maple, 36" dia., bears S.24°E., 100 lks., mkd: T20S R7W S17 BT.
- A Cedar, 30" dia., bears S.80°W., 118 lks., mkd: T20S R7W S18 BT.
- A Cedar, 30" dia., bears N.50°W., 123 lks., mkd: T20S R7W S7 BT.

BLM dependent resurvey by Lynn M. Roseberry & Wm. W. Glenn, Cadastral Surveyors, under Group #350 & 622, surveyed Oct. 1966/May 1967 (DCSO rec. Vol. 34 Page(s) 14156)

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The cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17, & 18, monumented with the orig. sandstone 20x16x5" firmly set 16" in the ground mkd. with 5 notches on the E edge, from which the remaining orig. BTs:

- A burned maple shell, 40" dia., bears S.28°E., 100 lks., with healed blaze. (Rec. S.24°E.)
- A burned cedar, 32" dia., bears S.86°W., 108 lks., with a burned blaze, no scribe marks visible. Rescribed T20S R7W S18 BT on new blaze. (Rec. S.80°W., 118 lks.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28" long, 2½" dia., 24" in the ground, with brass cap marked:

from which new BTs

- A sawed & burned cedar stump, 85" dia., bears N.70°E., 65 lks., mkd: T20S R7W S8 BT.
- A burned double maple, 58" dia., bears S.42½°E., 128 lks., mkd: T20S R7W S17 BT.

No other suitable trees available within limits.

Deposit the orig stone & set a steel fence post alongside the iron post.

The cor. falls 37 lks., north of South Sister Creek, 10 lks. wide, course SW.
