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The point falling on a sandstone in place, 60x30", 12" above ground, which I marked with cross (X) at exact corner point, with ¼ on N face for ¼ sec. cor.; from which  
A Fir, 24" dia., bears N.18°W., 35 lks., mkd: ¼ S BT.  
A Fir, 4" dia., bears S.13°E., 36 lks., mkd: ¼ S BT.

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Wilford N. Haines - For: Woolley Logging - 11/17/1967 - M35-3

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Found - Rock with "X" and "S"  
No old bearing trees.  
Set - 5/8" steel rod West 2.35 ft.  
Scribed- 12" Fir S.52°W., 26.5 ft.  
16" Fir N.29°W., 11.4 ft.  
Note - This corner in Oxbow fire area - 60 ft. east of ridge not 2.0 chains.
