Set post 4 ft. long, 4" sq. 24" in ground for cor. to secs. 34 & 35, marked T20S R7W on N. face,; S34 on W.; S35 on E. faces, with 2 notches on E. & 4 notches on W. faces; from which

A Maple 12" dia., bears N.62°E., 74 lks. dist. mkd. T20S R7W S35 BT.

A Chinquapin 6" dia., bears S.22°W., 49 lks. dist. mkd. T20S R7W S34 & 35 BT.

A Fir 30" dia., bears N.58°W., 72 lks. dist. mkd. T20S R7W S34 BT.

Wilford Haines - Date unknown - Haines field book, H-64

Found - Old Fir BT, N.58°W., 49 lks. (Dead snag, bark scribed)

Set - Brass cap
6" D.Fir, N.66°W., 84.6 ft., scribed "S.34 T20S R7W BT"

The Sec. Cor., perpetuated by Haines during an unrecorded survey, year unknown, monumented with a 1" "T" shaped iron rod, firmly set, projecting 6" above ground, with a washer, 1" dia., mkd. Wilford N. Haines 239 Survey Point Drain Oregon, from which the remains of an original bearing tree:

A decayed Chinquapin snag, 18" dia., bears S.22°W., 49 lks. dist., with axe marks visible.

At the corner point

Set an alum. post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 24" in the ground, directly over the iron rod with alum. cap mkd:
