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Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4" square, 24" in the ground, for cor. to secs. 26, 27, 34, & 35, marked T20S S26 on NE R7W S35 on SE, S34 on SW, S27 on NW faces, with 2 notches on E & 1 on S edges; from which  
A dogwood, 4" dia., bears N.32°E., 39 lks., mkd: T20S R7W S26 BT.  
A fir, 3" dia. bears S.45°E., 60 lks. mkd: T20S R7W S35 BT  
A fir, 48" dia. bears S.32°W. 40 lks. mkd: T20S R7W S34 BT  
A fir, 60" dia. bears N.40°W. 80 lks. mkd: T20S R7W S27 BT

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Found - 2 orig. BTs  
Orig. 60" now 72" fir stump. I open & find good scribing "BT", record N.40°W. I find should be N.46°W., 52.8 ft.  
Orig. 48" now 60" fir stump shows good scar. I do not open. Checks rec. dist. & bearing S.32°W., 26.4 ft.  
Set brass cap at cor. mkd: S27|S26 County Surveyors Office

New BTs- 8" Hemlock bears S.82°E., 5.7 ft., mkd: S35 T20S R7W CS BT  
6" Hemlock bears S.13½°W., 33.8 ft., mkd: S34 CS BT  
10" Cedar bears N.12°E., 80.0 ft., mkd: S26 T20S R7W CS BT  
No suitable trees near in NW

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The cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, & 35, perpetuated & recorded by Byron in 1958, monumented with an iron post, 1¼" dia, firmly set projecting 6" above ground with brass cap (properly) mkd. from which the remains of the Orig. BTs  
A sawed fir stump, 72" dia., bears N.51°W., 80 lks., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on opened blaze. (Rec. N.40°W.)  
A sawed fir stump 60" dia., bears S.27°W., 40 lks., with healed blaze. (rec. S.32°W.)  
and BTs mkd by Byron  
A hemlock, 18" dia., bears S.87½°E., 9 lks., with healed blaze.  
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A cedar, 21" dia., bears N.8½°E., 121 lks., with healed blaze.  
and new BTs  
A fir, 5" dia., bears S.3°W., 67 lks., mkd: X BT.  
An alder, 7" dia., bears N.52°W., 26 lks., mkd: T20S R7W S27 BT on bark.
