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Found - Sandstone rock, 16" x 8", about 16" above ground, mkd. "CC" on top. Haines "T" Iron and cap driven alongside. Rock and "T" iron pushed partly over by log which had fallen on top of them.

Old Fir snag, badly rotted, S.12°E., 11.2 ft. with scribing, "6" "S31" visible on previously opened old face.

No trace of orig. SW. or NW. trees found.

44" Fir N.16½°W., 30.0 ft., bark scribed "T20S R6W CC S25". Haines metal disc also nailed to tree - "BT 363".

New BT - 5" D.Fir S.71°W., 66.3 ft. mkd. "CS BT".

Did not set brass cap.
