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A fir, 38" dia., bears S.60°W., 17 lks., mkd with a healed blaze. Rotted 35" dia. x 4' high stump
A fir, 25" dia., bears S.49½°E., 37 lks., mkd: T20S R8W S8 BT. Down, rotted
A fir, 12" dia., bears N.73°W., 57 lks., mkd: T20S R8W S6 BT. Down, rotted
New - 17" D.Fir bears N.44°W., 3.6 ft. blazed, scribed T20S R8W S6 BT
22" D.Fir bears S.79°W., 36.5 ft. blazed, scribed T20S R8W S7 BT
21" D.Fir bears S.31°W., 27.7 ft. blazed, scribed T20S R8W S7 BT
20" D.Fir bears N 69°E., 25.6 ft. blazed, scribed T20S R8W S5 BT
Note - Corner has steel post adjacent to it. All BTs have red painted bands and yellow tags.

A fir, 22" dia., bears S.80°W., 36.4 ft., with scribe marks T20S R8W S7 BT visible on partially opened blaze.
A fir, 17" dia., bears N.43¾°W., 3.6 ft., with scribe marks T20S R8W S6 BT visible on partially opened blaze.
