Rescribed ¼ S24 BT on new blaze.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A burned fir snag, 38" dia., bears N.21¼°W., 106 lks., no marks remaining on burned blaze. Rescribed ¼ S23 BT on new blaze.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Set a 6 ft. steel fence post alongside the iron post.</p>
