A tin-capped cedar stump, 32" dia., bears N.54¾°E., 12.9 ft., with no marks visible on partially healed blaze.

Set a stainless steel post, 28" long, 2½" dia., 24" in the ground, directly over iron rod, with brass cap mkd.
