Original Corner never established.

At the properly proportioned position, I placed a 2" x 36" galv. I.P., flanged at the bottom and capped with a bronze disk welded on top. Monument projects 6" above ground. I filled in around the pipe monument with stone and packed earth. I stamped the disk:

1971
4185

I established new bearing trees as follows. Each BT has a scribed face and a U.S.F.S. BT sign breast high and facing the monument.

A 28" Fir bears N.40°E., 24.1 ft.

A 20" Fir bears N.24°E., 34.6 ft.
