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Set stone, 15x12x4, for corner to secs.29, 30, 31, & 32; from which  
 A Maple, 12" dia., bears N.45°W., 33 lks.

BLM dependent resurvey by Thomas A. Tillman,, under Group # 297, Surveyed May 1951 thru Oct 1952 - (DCSO records Vol. 27 Pg 11715)

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The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, & 32, monumented with a sandstone, 16x12x5 ins., firmly set 10" in the ground, marked with 1 notch on S edge, the E edge being crumbled, and located at the intersection of old blazed lines. The orig. BT is gone.  
 At the corner point  
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2" dia., 28" in the ground, with brass cap mkd:

 A Fir, 24" dia., bears N.1½°W., 59 lks., mkd: T20S R10W S30 BT.

Reset sandstone alongside.

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Found - 1951 GLO brass cap, properly mkd., out of ground. 12" now 15" Cedar, alive, S.49°W., 7.9 ft., scribe visible on nearly healed blaze.  
 NW BT has slid downhill, now stump, SE BT now stump in proper position. NE BT turned out.

Reset - Brass cap at corner point.  
 New BTs- 10" D.Fir North 53.2 ft. mkd: T20S R10W S29 CS BT.  
 10" Maple S.67°E. 28.8 ft. mkd: T20S R10W S32 CS BT.  
 No trees available in Sec. 30.

This corner lies on very steep southerly slope.
