We failed to find any trees that had ever been scribed - we do not find any IP - A maple tree, now 12" dia., has a tag but is not scribed or marked in any way to indicate it is a BT - The only we find has some blazes on 3 sides no scribe - The area is very steep & has been clear cut - in my opinion even the 1957 corner has been destroyed.
