A Vine Maple, 4" dia., bears S.68°W., 14 lks.

A Chittewood, 5" dia., bears S.70°E., 16 lks.

BLM dependent resurvey by Thomas A. Tillman,, under Group # 297, Surveyed May 1951 thru Oct 1952 - (DCSO records Vol. 27 Page(s) 11713)

Point for the meander cor. of secs. 33 & 34, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the orig. corner. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1" dia., 28" in the ground with brass cap marked:

A double Willow, 48" dia., bears N.41°E., 14 lks., mkd: ¼ S34 MC BT.

An Alder, 20" dia., bears S.56½°W., 65 lks., mkd: ¼ S33 MC BT.

Found - 1951 GLO iron pipe & brass cap lying on ground. Re-set pipe & cap from NE Willow BT.

48" downed Willow, N.41°E., 9.2 ft. (no marks) 1951 BT. Rec. N.41°E., 9.2 ft.

SW Alder BT was washed away by Smith River.

Set - 72" alum. post with land survey mon. sign attached beside brass cap.

18" Maple, S.50°W., 33.8 ft. (scribed/painted red)

24" Alder, S.83°E., 31.7 ft (bark scribed/paint red)

Note - Corner lies 25 ft. East of Smith River and 15 ft. North of small draw. Draw bears N.80°W.
