 A Hemlock, 20" dia., bears N.70°E., 76 lks., mkd: T20S R10W S11 BT.
 A Fir, 10" dia., bears S.41°E., 64 lks., mkd: T20S R10W S14 BT.
 An Alder, 5" dia., bears S.23°W., 14 lks., mkd: T20S R10W S15 BT.
 An Alder, 7" dia., bears N.54°W., 30 lks., mkd: T20S R10W S10 BT.

 A 10" Yew with healed face and tag bears S.46°E., 18.48'.
New BTs- A 17" Hemlock, face scribed "SW S11 BT" with X-chop and tag bears N.68°E., 14.5' to a spike at side center.
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A 21" Hemlock, face scribed "NE S15 BT" with X-chop & tag bears S.30°W., 15.5' to a spike at side center.

An 18" Fir, face scribed "SE S10 BT" with X-chop and tag bears N.79°W., 20.2' to a spike at side center
