Found - 1½" iron post by Powell, DCSO in 1969 per C.S. 53/66 now firmly set, projecting 8" above the top of a new 24" dia. x 8" high mound of stone with 2½" brass cap (properly) stamped

From which a BT by Hootman in 1959 per M15-22:

A 36" D.Fir stump bears N.87°45'E., 19.3 ft. with rotted face.(rec. N.85°E., 20.0 ft.)

And a BT by Powell in 1969 per C.S File 53/66:

A 30" hemlock bears N.30°15'E., 22.8 ft. with healed single blaze (rec. N.29°E., 23.6 ft.)

New BTs- 21" hemlock bears S.29°15'E., 26.7 ft. scribed "¼ S16 BT"

16" D.Fir bears S.32°30'W. 17.1 ft scribed "¼ S17 BT"

19" D.Fir bears N.82°45'W. 14.9 ft scribed "¼ S17 BT"
