A Maple 10" dia., bears S.78°00'E., 14 lks. dist. mkd. X 4 HES 190 BT.  
A Fir 24" dia., bears N.84°00'E., 63 lks. dist. mkd. X 4 HES 190 BT.  
Raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3½ ft. dist. within the claim.
