A Fir 4" dia., bears N.7½°E., 55 lks. dist. mkd. T20S R11W S1 BT.

An Alder 5" dia., bears S.62°E., 75 lks. dist. mkd. T20S R11W S12 BT.

An Alder 4" dia., bears S.8½°W., 23 lks. dist. mkd. T20S R11W S11 BT.

A Chittem 3" dia., bears N.17 3/4°W., 40 lks. dist. mkd. T20S R11W S2 BT.

22" Fir N.52°W., 56.8 ft. "T20S R11W S2 BT"

Corner falls 50 ft. West of small intermittent stream flowing S.20°W. approx. 300 ft. North of westerly flowing creek (a fork of 5 Mile Creek)
