To Pacific Ocean. Set meander post; drove charred stake; raised mound with trench, as per instructions.

Point selected for the witness corner to the meander cor. of secs. 19 and 30, on the shore of the Pacific Ocean. Set an aluminum rod, 4 ft. long, 5/8" dia., 42" in the ground, in concrete, with alum. cap mkd. WC T20S MC S19 S30 R12W 1982 (with arrow pointing to true cor.)

No suitable trees available.

Set a steel fence post alongside aluminum rod.

Mean high tide and shore of the Pacific Ocean, bears N.10°E. and S.6½°W.; true point for the meander cor. of secs. 19 and 30, on the shore of the Pacific Ocean, at record distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. This point is located at edge of beach, where it is impracticable to establish a permanent monument.
