Set post corner of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, from which
A Spruce 10" dia., bears S.84°W., 90 lks. dist.
A Spruce 48" dia., bears S.11°E., 53 lks. dist.
A Spruce 48" dia., bears N.72°W., 100 lks. dist.
A Spruce 24" dia., bears N.22°E., 54 lks. dist.

Found two BTs at the corner and from them relocated corner. Set 1½" I.P., from which bears:
48" Spruce snag, S.84°W., 52.8 ft. All marks covered if any are there. Cruiser's marks Y X on N. and W. side. Orig. 48" Spruce stump S.11°E., 34.98 ft. scribed BT. Rest of inscription covered.
Orig. 48" Spruce N.72°W., 66 ft. showing marks. Now lies across gulch bearing NE. There has been a slide where it once stood.
Orig. 24" Spruce N.22°E., 35.64 ft. Has fallen over and rotted away. Only small chunks remain.
I marked:
A 12" Spruce N.43°E., 16.6 ft. to nail "BT S27" with crayon.

Found - 48" now 42" dia. 6 ft. high Spruce stump with scribing visible on a partially healed blaze "S34 T20S R12W" bears S.11°E., 35.0 ft., horizontal (as per rec.)
No other original BTs found.
BT from 1941 not found.
Area recently logged, corner in slide area.
Set a 2 3/8" dia. Brass cap on a 1¼" O.D. x 31" long iron pipe, is set at rec. brg. & dist. from remaining orig. BT. BC/IP protrudes 1' above a 2 ft. dia. mound of sandstone, cap mkd: Douglas County Surveyors Office

40" dia. 4 ft. high Spruce stump, boat spike stamped "BO 1" is set through BT tag on top, near center. Boat spike bears N.71°W., 91.2 ft.

31" dia. 4 ft. high Spruce stump, boat spike stamped "BO 2" is set through BT tag on top near center. Boat spike bears S.81½°W., 84.4 ft.

Center pylon where boats cross under railroad tressle over Five Mile Arm of Tahkenitch Lake, bears N.5°W.
