Set a 2" x 36" concrete filled galv. I.P. with 3" brass cap fully stamped, from which
24" Spruce bears S.88°W., 34.2 ft. to face, scribed C ¼ S3 BT.
24" Spruce bears N.51½°E., 35.2 ft. to face, scribed C ¼ S3 BT.

Point for the center ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 3, at intersection with the E. and W. center line.

A Spruce 26" dia., bears N.69°E., 13 lks. dist. mkd. C¼ S3 BT.
A Cedar 22" dia., bears N.19°W., 18 lks. dist. mkd. C ¼ S3 BT.

From this point, a point established and recorded by Karl F. Foeste, LS #849, in 1974, bears S.51°13'W., 0.345 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 2" dia., firmly set, projecting 2" above ground, with brass cap mkd. LS 849 C ¼ S3 1974, from which bearing trees mkd. by Foeste
A Spruce 22" dia., bears N.50½°E., 54½ lks. dist. with partially healed blaze, no marks visible.
A Spruce 25" dia., bears S.87½°W., 53½ lks. dist., with partially healed blaze, no marks visible.
