 An Alder 18" dia., bears N.54°W., 33 lks. dist.
 A Spruce 30" dia., bears S.18°E., 34 lks. dist.

Found orig. 30" Spruce BT after cutting through 14" of over-growth. From this BT., relocated the corner as the Alder was missing.
 Set 1½" I.P. and 2"x2"x5 ft. Fir post, crayon mkd. S26 S35 M.C. 1943, from which
 Orig. 30" Spruce, now 7 ft. stump bears S.18°E., 22.44 ft. to nail scribed "R12", rest covered. Had to cut through 14" of wood to find the inscription. Tough going. This corner stands on steep slope 30 ft. above water. The compass needle was not swinging freely. Bearing from pipe to BT should be checked with good compass.

Found - 1½" I.D. iron pipe leaning 12" East of a plumb position.
 30" now 50" dia., 7' high Spruce stump, knife made scribe marks "R1" and nail from 1943 visible on East trunk of stump. Nail bears S.15°E., 22.4', center of stump bears S.10°E., 22.4' (Orig. Rec. S.18°E., 22.4'). North side of stump shows evidence of being previously opened no evidence of scribing or blazes visible.

Set 2 3/8" dia., brass cap on a 1 3/8" O.D. by 32" long iron pipe is set a plumb position of found 1½" I.P. protrudes 5" above ground. Stamped:

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46" dia., Hemlock double blazed & scribed "MC S35 CS BT" bears S.73°W., 29.6'.

19" dia., Alder bark scribed "MC S26 CS BT" bears N.68°E., 29.3'.

18" dia., Pistol Butt Cascara bark scribed "MC S26 CS BT" also BT tap w/PK nail to top, PK nail bears N.6½°W. 18.4'.
