 An Alder 10" dia., bears S.21°W., 28 lks. dist.

(Ran compass line North, Var. 21°30'E., to Lake line and distance came close to old Alder tree. Assuming it to be a BT, we relocated M.C.:
Set 1½" I.P. and 2"x2"x2 ft. white post, crayon mkd. "S35|36 9+66" from which:
 24" rotten Alder snag S.21°W., 18.48 ft., no marks.
 16" Alder N.81°E., 12.5 ft. to nail, crayon mkd. "RPBT 9+66 M.C. RLF".
This pipe stands 2.6 ft. West of our compass line, run N. from ¼ cor. 35 & 36, thus making true line N.0°9'W., 966.0 ft. from ¼ cor.

Found - 2" iron pipe 2 feet high in lake. (C.S. File 52/91)
Set ¾" x 5 ft. iron rod with 2" aluminum cap marked "Stuntzner Engineering MC S35 S36 1994 LS 1342"
New BTs -37" Spruce, face scribed "MC S36 BT" with X-chop and tag at B.H. bears S.13°E., 66.0 ft. to a spike at side center.
 13" Alder, bark scribed "MC S35 BT" with X-chop and tag bears southwest along shoreline.
Bearing Object - The shoreline bears South, 2 feet.
