1st on the east line of RR R/W
Found orig. R.R. County line marker post, set brass cap, mkd:
DOUGLAS COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE, 1964 LANE COUNTY

DOUGLAS COUNTY
A telephone pole on RR, mkd: SPD S-60 SPC8 7 25, bears
N.3°W., 48.6 ft. (First pole south of mile post.)
2nd brass cap set N.89°43'40"E., 552.11' (from 1st BC.)
Set brass cap, mkd: DOUGLAS COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE, 1964
LANE COUNTY blazed and scribed:
DOUGLAS COUNTY
9" D.Fir S.13°E., 15.8' mkd: C.L. D.C.S. BT
32" D.Fir N.74°W., 19.0' mkd: C.L. D.C.S. BT

New County line Marker on East R/W line of S.P.R.R. (on E-W
centerline of section 1)

Set a 2 3/8" dia., brass cap marked "T20S R12W C ____ C S1 1989
Office" on a 1 3/8" O.D. x 32" long galv. iron pipe, is
firmly set and protruding approx. 5" above ground, from which
11" DBH Spruce, double blazed "S1 CS BT" bears N.64°W.,
11.2 ft.

8" DBH Spruce, double blazed "S1 CS BT" bears S.38°W., 8.3
ft.

A 5/8" Iron rod/alu.cap bears S.1½°E., 28.86 ft.
Monument is located on timbered bench between Ada Park Road
and S.P.R.R. tracks. Monument lies nearer railroad tracks.

Added 10/7/2025 JC DCS0:

1988 record of 1964 BC set by DCS0 (1st BC noted above)
Found - A 2½" (1964) brass cap (properly mkd) on a 1½" O.D.
iron pipe firmly set and protruding approx. 6"
above ground.

A 6x6" wooden county line marker post protruding
approx. 7 ft. from ground with NW side lettered
"LANE COUNTY" and SW side lettered "DOUGLAS
COUNTY" bears S.66°W., 0.9 ft..

A 7" dia., tall stub of a power pole (mkd "STDS - 60
SPC8 7 25" on cut portion) bears N.3°E., 48.6'
(rec. N.3°W. 48.6 ft)

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A later survey and BLM opinion show this monument to be in error. To save confusion we remove BC from pipe and place a 1¼" dia. plastic cap mkd: "DOUG CO SURVEYOR" in top of pipe.
Note - Just north of ADA resort along SP RR tracks.
Dec. 18½°E

This monument bears N.11°38'32"W., 77.69' from 1964 location.

1988 record of 1964 BC set by DCS0 (2nd BC noted above)
Found - A 2½" (1964) brass cap (properly mkd) on a 1½" O.D. iron pipe firmly set and protruding approx. 6" above ground.

A 9" now a 17" DBH D.Fir with fully healed double blaze bears S.13°W. 15.8 ft (rec S.13°E. 15.8 ft)

A 32" now 41" D.B.H. D.Fir with a fully healed single blaze bears N.74°E., 19.9 ft. (rec N.74°W., 19.0')

Brass cap set on DCS0 1964 BC/IP is sawed off, remaining IP felt in place and a plastic cap mkd: "DOUG CO SURVEYOR" is set in top of pipe. 1964 DCS0 survey by Godfrey (RM1-47) superseded in 1981 by Perry G. Fox survey (M88-13) BLM opinion show this monument to be in error to save confusion we remove cap from pipe.

Note - Decl. 18½°E

This monument bears N.59°34'20"E. 151.47' from 1964 location.
