New - A fir 10" dia., now a 12" dia. 7 ft tall D.Fir stump with a fully healed, single blaze (we do not open); bears S.21°W., 25.7 ft. (as per rec.) 1971
We remove log fallen on BC monument. Plumb position of fd buried, & tilted BC monument is referenced out, monument removed from ground (fd to measure 28" long) The monument is then re-established the reference out position is now firmly and plumbly set protruding 6" above the ground.
A 10" dia., dogwood scribed "X" "CS BT" on a high-low blaze (low blaze is 2 ft. above ground due to pistol butt trunk) bears S.85½°E., 10.2 ft.
A 6" dia., D.Fir scribed "¼ S18 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears S.24°E., 18.6 ft.
A 10" dia., D.Fir scribed "¼ S18 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears S.40½°W., 29.4 ft.
A 5" dia., D.Fir scribed "X" "CSBT" on a high-low blaze; bears N.65°W., 14.2 ft.
Note - Monument is on flattened top of large high ridge at north edge of older, D.Fir, re-prod & roughly east-west running south edge of old growth fir forest with some maple, chinq & dogwood under story
Compass decl. 15½°E.

BLM dependent resurvey by Jeffrey O. Covington, Cadastral Surveyor, under Group No. 2762, surveyed May/June 2015 - (DCSO records Vol. 58 Page 23469-70)

The ¼ sec cor. of secs. 7 & 18, perpetuated by Smith, Douglas Co Surveyor, in 2013, monumented with an iron post, 2½" dia., firmly set projecting 6" above ground, with brass cap (properly) mkd from which the remains of the bearing trees mkd. by Peterson and Berry in 1971-72
A root hole bears N.15°E., 32.3 ft., with fallen fir trunk, 18" dia., lying alongside, with a healed blaze.
A fir stump, 12" dia., bears S.21°W., 25.7 ft., with no marks visible.
and the bearing trees mkd. by Smith
A dogwood, 10" dia., bears S.85½°E., 10.0 ft., with scribe marks X CS BT visible on a partially healed blaze.
A fir, 6" dia., bears S.23½°E., 18.3 ft. with scribe marks ¼ S18 CS BT visible on a partially healed double blaze
A fir, 11" dia. bears S.40°W., 29.0 ft., with scribe marks ¼ S18 CS BT visible on a partially healed double blaze.
A fir, 5" dia., bears N.64°W., 14.3 ft with scribe marks X CS BT visible on a partially healed double blaze.
