A Hemlock 15" dia., bears N.85°W., 21 lks.
A Cedar 24" dia., bears N.10°E., 56 lks.

Location identified from an old post bearing scribe marks
lying on the ground, from which found
A Cedar 28" dia., S.75°E., 27.1 ft. which has been blazed
and scribed by some previous surveyor.
I found the rotted stumps of a Hemlock and a Cedar which
checked for bearing and distance with those shown in
the original records of the govt. survey. No scribe
marks were visible on these old stumps.
Set an iron bar, 1/2" x 2" x 36" long, 24" in the ground for
the corner. Drove a Yewood post alongside, scribed DLC 7 CS
Remarked -
The 28" Cedar S.75°E., 27.1 ft.
New BT -
A Cedar 24" dia., N.42°W., 59.1 ft.

Found - Iron bar set by Irving in 1941.
Cedar, N.42°W., 59.1 ft. This is now a snag approx.

portion of face chopped away, remainder of face
and scribing good.
