Found Fir stump 48", at corner, scribing "S21 T21S" visible on NE. face, previously opened. Good scar on NW. face, not opened. Scribe "S29" visible on SW. face, previously opened. No scar visible on SE. face. Ring count shows scribing to have been made about the time of original survey. Remnants of old Maple stump and Maple sprouts bears N.63°W., 14.5 ft. No trace found of any other orig. BTs. I believe this stump to have been mkd. for corner by orig. survey although not called for in orig. notes. Haines "T" iron driven in center of stump.
Did Not Set Brass Cap. Stump 48" dia. & 6 ft. high is corner.

28" D.Fir S.53°E., 36.7 ft. to rail spike set @ center of stump.
