Set post, 4" dia., 4 ft. long, with marked stone, 12" in ground, for qr. sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N face; from which Cedar, 40" dia., bears S.29°E., 100 lks., mkd: $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.
Fir, 40" dia., bears N.37°W., 144 lks., mkd: $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

Found - 40" I.Cedar stump of orig. BT, S.29°E., 66 ft. with good scribing.

NW BT missing.

Set - An \perp iron rod (1"x36") at point for corner, with brass cap attached, inscribed "Wilford N. Haines survey pint #239"

Scribed 2 new BTs & hung yellow BLM tags on them:

10" Fir, S.03°W., 19.3 ft. ($\frac{1}{4}$ S BT 363)

40" Fir, N.30°W., 60.7 ft. ($\frac{1}{4}$ S BT 363)
