 Fir, 40" dia. bears N.50°W., 114 lks. mkd: T21S R7W S26 BT
 Fir, 24" dia. bears N.47°E., 56 lks. mkd: T21S R7W S25 BT.
 Fir, 24" dia., bears S.5°E., 72 lks. mkd: T21S R7W S36 BT.
 Fir, 30" dia. bears S.10°W., 38 lks. mkd: T21S R7W S35 BT

 A Fir, 10" dia. bears N.41°E., 39½ lks. with healed blaze.
 A Fir, 14" dia. bears S.70¼°E., 42½ lks. with healed blaze
 A Fir, 12" dia. bears S.13½°W., 38 lks. with healed blaze.
 A Fir, 8" dia., bears N.11°W., 30 lks., with healed blaze.
