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GLO survey by Wm. P. Wright, Deputy Surveyor, under contract #486, dated Aug. 1, 1883 - (DCSO recs. Vol. 2 Page(s) 870)

Set post 6" dia., 4 ft. long with marked stone 12" in ground for corner to secs. 4, 5, 8, & 9, marked T21S, S 4 on NE, R8W, S 9 on SE, S 8 on SW, S 5 on NW face with 4 notches on E and 5 on S edge from which:

- Maple, 24" dia., bears N.2°E., 47 lks., mkd: T21S R8W S4 BT.
- Fir, 10" dia., bears S.7°E., 21 lks., mkd: T21S R8W S9 BT.
- Fir, 10" dia., bears S.28°W., 12 lks., mkd: T21S R8W S8 BT
- Fir, 12" dia., bears N.57°W., 15 lks., mkd: T21S R8W S5 BT

BLM dependent resurvey by Norman D. Price, Cadastral Eng. & Geo. F. Rigby, Assoc. Cadastral Eng., under group #282, surveyed May/Aug. 1945 - (DCSO records Vol. 27 Page(s) 11411)

The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, & 9, the locus of which is determined at the record dist. from the old NE BT, & record bearing & dist. from the old SW & NW BTs.

At point for corner

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2" dia., 28" in the ground, for cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, & 9, with brass cap marked:

S 5	S 4
S 8	S 9

from which

- A burnt dead Maple, 36" dia., bears N.2°W., not N.2°E., 47 lks., on which no marks remain. (OBT)
- A burnt dead Fir, 16" dia., S.28°W., 12 lks., with partial scribe marks on face of old blaze. (OBT)
- A burnt dead Fir, 30" dia., bears N.57°W., 15 lks., on which I uncover the scribe marks BT T21S R8W S5. (OBT)
- A Fir, 32" dia., bears S.46½°W., 96 lks., mkd: T21S R8W S8 BT. (New BT)

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W of cor.

BLM remonumentation of certain orig. corner points by Wm. W. Glenn & James E. Jelley, Cadastral Surveyors, under group #s 350 & 635, surveyed April/May 1967 - (DCSO records C.S. File 65/27-1)

The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, & 9, determined at record bearing & distance from the remaining OBTs:

- A burned Fir stump, size indeterminate, bears S.28°W., 12 lks., no marks remaining.
- A burned Fir stump, size indeterminate, bears N.57°W., 15 lks., no marks remaining.

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
