A fir, 50" dia., bears S.26½°E., 36.3 ft., with a healed blaze.

A roothole bears S.49½°W., 37.0 ft., with a down fir, 54" dia., alongside with axe marks on loose bark. and a BT mkd. by Milo Godfrey, in 1963

A fir, 49" dia., bears N.53°E., 22.2 ft., with a healed blaze. and BTs mkd. by Smither, in 2005

A fir, 9" dia., bears S.46°E., 16.7 ft., with scribe marks T22 R8 ¼ S1 BT visible on pitched-over partially healed blaze, and a spike on the left side center.

A fir, 10" dia., bears S.30°W., 7.7 ft., with scribe marks T22 R8 ¼ S1 BT visible on pitched-over partially healed blaze, and a spike on the left side center.

An aluminum fence post is alongside the cor.
Corner is located 3 ft. downhill from the down Lytle SW BT.
