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- Set post to cor. of secs. 6, 5, 7, & 8, from which
- A Fir, 30" dia., bears S.43°W., 93 lks.
 - A Fir, 48" dia., bears N.20¼°W., 73 lks.
 - A Fir, 48" dia., bears N.36½°E., 96 lks.
 - A Fir, 48" dia., bears S.52°E., 55 lks.

GLO survey by Alonzo Gesner, Deputy Surveyor, under Contract #608, dated April 17, 1893 - (DCSO rec. Vol. 2 Page(s) 981)

The cor. secs. 5 & 6, could not find old post. I re-established the corner as follows.

Set Fir post, 4½ ft. long, 4" dia., 24" in the ground for cor. to secs. 5 & 6 mkd: T21S S 5, in NE, R9W 6 on the NW faces with 5 notches on the S & E edges, from which

- A dead Fir, 48" dia., bears N.36°E., 102 lks., mkd: T21S R9W S5 BT.
- A dead Fir, 48" dia., bears S.52°E., 55 lks., mkd: T21S R9W S8 BT.
- A dead Fir, 30" dia., bears S.46°30'W., 93 lks., marks obliterated.
- A dead Fir, 48" dia., bears N.24°W., 78 lks., mkd: BT T21S R9W S6.

All the BTs were mkd. in the bark & agreeing in part to the field notes furnished me by the US Surveyor General

BLM dependent resurvey by Peter A. Peterson, Cadastral Surveyor, under Group #350 & 511, surveyed April 1966/May 1967 - (DCSO records, Vol. 34 Page(s) 14261-2)

The cor. of secs. 5 & 6 only, on the N bdy. of sec. 7 & determined at rec. bearing & dist. from the orig. BTs:

- A Fir snag, 55" dia., bears N.36°E., 102 lks., with healed blaze.
- A rotted Fir stump, 40" dia., bears S.52°E., 55 lks., with no marks remaining.
- A Fir snag, 34" dia., bears S.46½°W., 93 lks., with scribe marks S T21 R9 visible on open blaze.
- A Fir snag, 50" dia., bears N.24°W., 78 lks., with no marks visible.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28" long, 2½" dia., 22" in the ground, with brass cap marked:

T 21 S R 9 W
