Set Fir post, 4½ ft. long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground on hill side sloping south for ¼ sec. cor., mkd: ¼ S on the W face; from which

- A Fir, 10" dia., bears S.85°E., 9 lks., mkd: ¼ S BT.
- A Fir, 12" dia., bears S.67°W., 11 lks., mkd: ¼ S BT.

BLM dependent resurvey by Peter A. Peterson, Cadastral Surveyor, under Group #350 & 511, surveyed April 1966/May 1967 - (DCSO records, Vol. 34 Page(s) 14231)

The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 & 2 determined at the record bearing & distance from the orig. BTs:

- A fir snag, 12" dia., bears S.85°E., 9 lks. with scribe marks ¼ S visible on opened blaze.
- A fir snag, 15" dia., bears S.67°W., 11 lks., with scribed marks BT visible on opened blaze.

A decayed fir pile, size indeterminate, bears S.67°W., 7.3 ft., no marks visible.

and the remains of a bearing tree mkd. by Peterson

A shattered decayed fir stump, size indeterminate, bears S.54°E., 15.2 ft., no marks visible.

and the bearing trees mkd. by Baker

A fir, 45" dia., bears S.15½°E., 30.4 ft., with a healed blaze and nail left side center.

A fir, 18" dia., bears S.88°W., 17.5 ft., with a healed blaze and nail right side center. A second fir is growing from the same base to the S.

An aluminum fence post with International Paper Company sign is alongside the cor.

Corner is located N., 370 ft., of a creek, 4 ft. wide, course W., on the N edge of bottom land, 20 ft. wide.
