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Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1" dia., 26" in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

from which

An Alder, 16" dia., bears S.84°W., 62 lks., mkd: 1/4 S13 BT.

A Hemlock, 16" dia., bears N.72°W., 59 lks., mkd: 1/4 S12 BT.
