Found - Orig. 30" Fir, now stump, bears West, 2.6 ft. with scribe visible on open face.

Remains of the Cedar BT (roots) bears East 4 ft± New BT - 12" Alder bears N.30°30'E., 15.2 ft., scribed.

Found - 2½" dia., brass cap on a 1½" O.D. iron pipe, protrudes 10" above ground.

30" now 30" dia., 3½ ft. high D.Fir stump with a rotted blaze, no scribing visible, bears N.65°W., 2.6 ft. (Rec. West, 2.6 ft.) OBT

12" now badly rotted remains of an Alder, no blaze or scribing visible, possible root hole found at record "N.30½°E., 15.2 ft."

Orig. East BT now gone.

New BTs- 16" dia., Alder, double blazed and scribed "¼ S7 CS BT", bears S.69°W., 7.0 ft.

6" dia., Alder, bark scribed "¼ S8 CS BT", bears S.7½°E., 24.7 ft.

6" dia, Pistol butt Spruce, double blazed and scribed "¼ S8 CS BT" root crown bears N.1½°E., 26.4 ft.

4" dia., Pistol butt, multi-trunked, Cedar scribed "X BT" on Northerly trunk center of plumb

Northerly trunk bears S.33½°E., 38.9 ft.

Note - Corner lies approx. 80 ft. East of a draw.

A 12" alder with visible bark scribe and tag bears S.7°30'E., 24.7'.
A 14" spruce with healed face and tag bears N.01°30'E., 27.4' record 26.4'.
A 20" multi-trunked cedar with possible healed face bears S.33°30'E., 40.2' record 38.9'.
New - A 17" alder bark scribed "W¼ S8 BT" with x-chop and tag bears N.32°E., 44.6' to a spike at side center.
