A 14" D.B.H., Red Alder, scribed "CS 1/16 CS BT" on a double blaze, bears N.3½'E., 305.9'

A 6" D.B.H., D.Fir, scribed "CS 1/16 CS BT" on a double blaze, bears S.54 3/4'W., 256.7'.

Monument is in pasture bottom land at the East edge and North end of a small canyon. This canyon runs Southerly from a point near the West end of a small valley which runs East to the Smith River.
