Set a post 4½ ft. long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground for cor. to secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, marked T21S S12 on NE.; R11W S13 on SE.; S14 on SW.; S11 on NW. faces, with 4 notches on South and 1 notch on E. edge, from which

- A Fir 48" dia., bears N.75½°E., 48 lks. dist. mkd. T21S R11W S12 BT.
- A Fir 42" dia., bears S.55°E., 45 lks. dist. mkd. T21S R11W S13 BT.
- A Fir 42" dia., bears N.84½°W., 63 lks. dist. mkd. T21S R11W S11 BT.
- An Alder 8" dia., bears S.9°W., 38 lks. dist. mkd. T21S R11W S14 BT.

Found - An old Fir stump with cruiser marks S.55°E., 29.7 ft  
A 92" Fir snag N.75½°E., 31.9 ft.  
An 80" Fir stump N.84½°W., 43.4 ft.  
The remains of an Alder tree S.9°W., 25 ft.

No scribe marks were found but trees check well for bearing and dist. recorded in notes of original survey, although two did not check for size. The topography on the lines from the corner checked well with the notes.

I set a 1" x 78" alum. pipe 36" in the ground located by intersection of arcs from above described Fir BTs, from which

- 80" D.Fir stump bark scribed Sec. 11, T21S R11W BT, bears N.87°31'W., 43.4 ft.
- 92" D.Fir snag scribed Sec. 12, T21S R11W BT, bears N.74°32'E., 31.9 ft.
- 32" D.Fir tree bark scribed Sec. 13 T21S R11W BT, bears S.85°38'E., 90.2 ft.
- 94" D.Fir tree scribed Sec. 14, T21S R11W BT, bears S.79°36'W., 104.3 ft.

The sec. cor., remonumented with an alum. pipe, 56" long, 1" dia. driven 24" in the ground, from which the remaining original bearing trees:

- A sawed Fir stump 60" dia., bears N.75½°E., 48 lks. dist. plainly blazed and healed.
