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Set 4" x 4" x 4 ft. post from old BT standing, which was a 12" Alder S.58°E., 25 lks.

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Corner searched for, not found. We search for the NE exterior "L" corner of DLC #37 which was reportedly found in 1925 however we find no trace of this corner. Note that the measurements quoted by Eppstein do not correspond with the orig. survey notes. This search was based on the location of the unrecorded monument found at the NE Interior Corner.
