We find no record of this monument in the records of the Douglas County Surveyor. To preserve the location of this monument, we mark the following BTs:

A 6" Alder bears S.51°E., 34.8 ft. scribed "RP CS BT"

A 20" Spruce bears N.40°E., 39.6 ft. scribed "RP CS BT"

The unrecorded monument which we find is located along the easterly edge of the cemetery at the North end of the town of Gardiner, approx. 1 ft. East of the retaining wall along the upper walkway and approx. 2.5 ft. North of the tombstone for Loyal E. Truesdale.

A 24" dia. x 5' tall spruce stump bears N.40°E., 39.6 (ft.) with a healed blaze.

A 30" dia. alder bears S.51°E., 33.6 ft with a healed blaze (Rec. 34.8')

A headstone marked "LOYAL E TRUESTONE" bears South 2.5 ft.

A bearing object by D. baker in 1987 -

A 3/4" dia. aluminum rod with a plastic cap bears East, 22.74 ft.

set in the right center root crown.)
The center of a 35 ft flag pole bears S.37°56'W.,
108.82 ft.
The S.W. Corner of the "HERMAN G. WILSON" headstone
bears N.4°34'W., 31.45 ft.

Note - Compass declination: 14¾°E.
