Set a Spruce post firmly in the ground and properly marked, from which
An Alder 12" dia., bears S.45°W., (? lks.)
A Spruce 30" dia., bears N.33°W., 10 lks. dist.
A Fir 60" dia., bears S.15°E., 38 lks. dist.
A Spruce 8" dia., bears S.35°W., 48 lks. dist.

Found - Unrecorded 3/4" I.P. protruding 6" above ground. Burned and rotted remains of probable orig. 12" now 30" Spruce stump. Stump has been chopped on recently and shows no scribing or blazed face. Stump bears N.33°W., 6.6 ft. of found 3/4" I.P. Stump has new I.P. BT tag.
Uprooted and burned 60" Fir stump probably from Cain's notes. No face or scribing visible. Approx. center of stump hole bears S.15°E., 27.5 ft. (Rec. 25.1 ft.)

Since I could not find any scribing or any other positive evidence, I DID NOT set brass cap but left 3/4" I.P. in place.

New Accessories:

- Spike in 36" Spruce stump stamped "B O 2" bears N.45°W., 76.5 ft.
- Spike in 18" Spruce stump stamped "B O 1" bears S.68°W., 44.3 ft.
- 16" exposed Spruce root growing vertically over an old stump bears N.27°E., 38.1 ft., scribed "NE CL 37 CS BT" in bark. (Brg. & Dist. taken to center of scribed portion of roots.) Above Spruce is growing out of old stump with scribed root growing down on the SW side.
