Found - No monument found.
Found a fence corner (fences running North and West) near rough GPS position.
One fir stump near fence corner has burlled wood but no definitive blaze evidence. This stump is close to orientation of 1922 renewal BT to the fence corner but distance is 6+ ft to long.
No other stumps or trees in area are large enough.
Note - Area searched in reprod. Fir forest; has been logged once or twice before.
