Found 1 3/4" Iron pipe and old 4" x 4" Oak post scribed "CS"
for corner.
According to the Woodard survey notes, C. Randall placed the
above 1 3/4" I.P. alongside the scribed 4x4" Oak post, which
he found in existence at the time of his survey. Randall's
survey notes also indicate that this corner is 21.2 ft. too
far to the East. In view of the fact that W. Haines used
this corner to establish the CE 1/16 corner in May, 1960, the
point was referenced by Wm. Wilt as described above.
