Set Stone post 8x8x18", from which
 A B.Oak, 24" dia., bears S.18°E., 195 lks.
 A W.Oak, 10" dia., bears S.82°W., 190 lks.

Found - Firmly set stone, top measured 10"x10" mkd. on south face "C 37 22 SW" and other illegible marks. Protrudes 4" above ground (rec. 8"x8"x18") we do not dig up. Orig.
10" now 30" dia. W.Oak we open & find good scribing and chaining notch "CA" bears S.82°W., 125.4 ft. (agrees w/rec.) OBT
Orig. SE BT not found.

New - Set 5/8"x30" long iron rod with a DCSO alum. cap stamped "DLC 37 2001" along West edge of stone bears West. 0.5 ft. from top center of corner stone, protrudes 9" above ground. Witness post & sign set along east edge of stone.

Brg. & dists. taken from top center of orig. stone.
12" dia., D.Fir double blazed & scribed "NNE DLC 37 CS BT" bears N.15°W., 15.9 ft.
16" dia., D.Fir double blazed & scribed "NNE DLC 37 CS BT" bears N.79°W., 24.2 ft.
10" dia., D.Fir double blazed & scribed "NNE DLC 37 CS BT" bears S.55½°W., 46.0 ft. (Note: this tree has a distinct broken top)

Note - Area around corner heavily covered in blackberries & brush.
Compass decl. 17 3/4°E.
