An Oak 15" dia., bears N.32 3/4°E., 1107 lks.
An Oak 18" dia., bears N.67°E., (? lks.)
An Oak 30" dia., bears S.89°E., 583 lks.

Found - 30" Oak, down, S.89°E., 583 lks.
Set 5/8" x 36" Steel rod, from which scribed:
8" Oak, one of a clump of three, N.39°E., 120.7 ft.,
10" Maple N.79°E., 91.0 ft.

Found - 5/8" x 36" I.Rod firmly set in a small mound of
stones.
An 8" now 9" W.Oak fork of a 3-forked clump, bears
N.39°E., 121.7 ft. (Rec. N.39°E., 120.7 ft.),
alive and well-healed. (our distance taken to
center of clump) (Haines BT)
A 10" now 21" Maple bears N.79°E., 91.0 ft., alive
with scribe marks visible on partially healed
blaze.

We also find the remains of an Oak at the proper
position for the orig. SE BT.
Set a 1" x 30" Iron pipe, set 27" in the ground and
surrounded by stones, with brass cap attached, marked:
