28" Oak bears S.71½°W., 15.8 ft. (rec S.74°W., 15.2 ft.) cut out face, Haines washer & tag.
15" D.Fir bears N.66¾°W., 26.1 ft. (rec. N.67°W., 26.5 ft) healed face & tag.
Note - Corner lies on slight West slope in mixed large Oaks & Conifer trees.
