

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION Center 1/4 Cor. for Sec. 33

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Wilford N. Haines - Haines Field Book, H-222

Iron pipe and 2 BTs, Center of Sect. 33

BLM resurvey by James E. Jelley and Wayne L. Rogers, under Group #1119, surveyed Oct. 1982/Feb. 1984 (DCSO records Vol. 46 Page(s) 17686-87)

Point for the center 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 33, at intersection with the E. and W. center line.

Set an alum. post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 26" in the ground, with alum. cap mkd:

T 22 S R 5 W
C 1/4 S 33
1983

from which

A Fir 6" dia., bears S.79 1/2°E., 26 lks., mkd. C 1/4 S33 BT.

A Fir 8" dia., bears N.16 3/4°W., 39 lks., mkd. C 1/4 S33 BT.

From this point, a locally established point, bears N.66°12'E., 0.240 chs. dist., monumented with an iron pipe, 1" dia., firmly set, projecting 26" above ground, from which bearing trees mkd. by person(s) unknown.

A Fir 28" dia., bears N.18°E., 8 1/2 lks., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on partially healed double blaze.

A Fir 24" dia., bears S.19°E., 50 lks., with healed double blaze.

Found - A 3/4" I.D. 39" long, iron pipe loose and out of position lying on ground approx. 6 ft. WNW from BLM record position. Haines

1983 3 3/4" dia., Alum. cap (properly mkd) on a 2 1/2" I.D. alum. pipe, protruding 6" above ground.

A fir 6" dia., now a 20" dia., D.Fir with a fully healed single blaze; bears S.79 1/2°E., 16.5 ft. (rec. S.79 1/2°E., 17.2 ft.) 1983

A fir 8" dia., now a 14" dia 15 ft tall rotted D.Fir snag with partially healed single blaze showing a rotted face with no scribing remaining; bears N.16 3/4°W., 25.7 ft. (as per record) 1983 Cont..

TOWNSHIP 22 RANGE 05 POINT IDENTIFIER # 340140

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New - Haines's NE BT is now a rotted low cut stump and the SE BT is gone (remove during road construction)

16" dia., D.Fir scribed "C¹/₄ S33" "CSBT" on a double blaze; bears N.34¹/₂°E., 24.0 ft.

6" dia., D.Fir scribed "X" "CSBT" on a high-low blaze; bears S.31¹/₂°W., 19.4 ft.

10" dia., D.Fir scribed "C¹/₄ S33 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears N.47³/₄°W., 39.1 ft.

Note - Monument is on flat ground in older fir reprod forest.

Sketch shows that the corner lies approximately 45' west of the centerline of a gravel road.

Compass decl. 15¹/₂°E.
