Both old bearing trees fallen but dim marks found on the SE BT. (tree fallen and badly decayed) Set a 7" x 10" x 14" stone and iron bar for ¼ cor. mkd. ¼S CS on stone. Marked two bearing trees:
8" W.Oak S.30°W., 26 lks. mkd. ¼ S B.T.C.S.
12" B.Oak N.10°E., 27 lks. mkd. ¼S B.T.C.S.

Found - Both BTs as recorded by Thiel:
12" B.Oak now 14", old face partly open, scribing visible, checks bearing and distance.
8" W.Oak now 8" closed face, checks dist. Bearing should be S.48°W. Both BTs partly dead.
Set brass cap alongside corner stone mkd: County Surveyors Office, 1958, S34|S35 ¼ T22S R5W.
New BTs -14" R.Fir bears N.86°W., 7.0 ft. scribed ¼ S34 CSBT
13" R.Fir bears S.3°W., 10.0 ft. scribed ¼ S34 CSBT

Found - Do. Co. Brass cap in good condition set in 1958
Bt's Fd.- 9" Oak, bears S.45°W., 16.8', well healed face
10" Oak, bears N.16°E., 16.6', well healed face
19" Douglas Fir, bears S.4¼°W., 9.3' well healed face and BLM tag.
21" Douglas Fir, bears N.89 ¾°W., 6.7', well healed face. Fence wraps around tree and runs west and south from tree .
