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Found - 20" Fir N.30°W., 200 lks., now stump, lower 2/3 of "S" plain.

Scribed -30" D.Fir S.48°W., 19.5 ft.  
10" D.Fir N.38°E., 11.2 ft. (This tree also scribed 1948 (approx) on East side.)
