 which  
 A 40" Fir bears N.13°W., 30 lks. dist.  
 A 40" Fir bears N.30°E., 35 lks. dist.

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The SE. cor. of Donation Land Claim No. 37, perpetuated and  
recorded by Frear in 1919, monumented with an iron rod, 1"  
dia., firmly set, projecting 6" above ground, from which the  
remains of the original bearing trees:

A Fir 50" dia., bears N.30°E., 35 lks. dist., with  
fragmentary scribe marks visible on bark blaze and with  
healed blaze.

A sawed Fir stump 44" dia., bears N.13°W., 30 lks. dist.,  
with healed blaze.

At the corner point  
 Set an iron post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 24" in the ground,  
 with brass cap mkd:

DLC 37 /  
 \ / S 17  
 \ / T 22 S R 6 W  
 1976

from which new bearing trees  
 A Grand Fir 9" dia., bears S.57 1/4°E., 39 lks. dist., mkd.  
 T22S R6W S17 BT.  
 A Grand Fir 14" dia., bears N.44 1/4°W., 55 1/2 lks. dist. mkd.  
 C37 BT.

Deposit iron rod alongside iron post.
